

**Wilderness Southeast, Inc. Nature Tour Participant  
Assumption of Risk, Release, Covenant Not to Sue, Hold Harmless and Indemnity Agreement**

In consideration for being allowed to participate in an educational nature/wildlife tour, which will involve walking, driving, or boating, organized by Wilderness Southeast, Inc. (hereinafter "WiSE Tour"), I, \_\_\_\_\_, ("Participant") and, if I am a minor child, my Parent or Legal Guardian \_\_\_\_\_ (collectively referred to hereinafter as "Participant") agree to the terms of this Assumption of the Risk, Release, Covenant Not to Sue, Hold Harmless and Indemnity Agreement (the "Agreement") with Wilderness Southeast, Inc.

**Assumption of Risk, Release & Covenant Not to Sue:** Participant acknowledges that there are risks associated with participating in a WiSE Tour including, but not limited to, property damage, personal injury, and the consequences thereof, including death, resulting from: 1) tides, currents, wave action, 2) collisions involving the Participants and another person, watercraft, motor vehicle or other manmade or natural object, 3) inclement weather or extreme temperatures, 4) cuts, burns, bruises, abrasions, and, 5) animal and insect bites, scratches, or stings. Participant agrees to assume these and similarly foreseeable risks associated with a tour organized by Wilderness Southeast, Inc.

The Participants further agree to release, covenant not to sue, and forever discharge Wilderness Southeast, Inc. and its officers, directors, employees, agents, guides, volunteers, successors, and assigns (collectively referred to hereinafter as "WiSE and Affiliates") from any and all claims, demands, rights and causes of action of any kind, regardless of foreseeability, including, but not limited to, claims for personal injuries, property damage, and the consequences thereof, including death, arising out of or in connection with Participant's participation in a WiSE Tour to the maximum extent allowed by law, including claims arising from the sole negligence of Wilderness Southeast Inc. and its Affiliates.

**Indemnification:** The Participants further agree to indemnify and hold harmless WiSE and Affiliates from any and all claims, demands, actions, and causes of action of whatever nature or character, including, but not limited, to claims for monetary damages, contribution, indemnity, reimbursement, attorney's fees, expenses of litigation, medical expenses, and other damages, that may be asserted against them by any person or entity, arising out of or alleged to have arisen out of any action taken by Participant, either alone or in connection with others, while participating in WiSE Tour regardless of whether such claims are asserted directly, by cross-claim or otherwise. However, nothing in this Agreement is intended to require the Participants to indemnify or hold harmless WiSE and Affiliates for and from claims arising or alleged to have arisen solely from their actions.

This Agreement will be governed by the laws of the State of Georgia. In the event that any portion or provision of this Agreement shall, for any reason, be held or become invalid or unenforceable, it is hereby agreed that the same shall not affect any other portion or provision of this Agreement, but that the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
